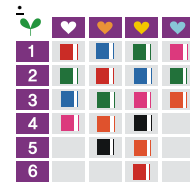

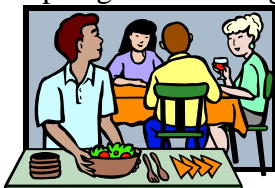
GREATER NEW ORLEANS FOUNDATION GRANT
