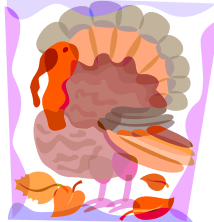


**EVELYN MENGE:

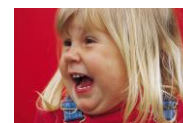
