Tuesday, January 22 is the first class day of the spring semester. We are closed for the Martin Luther King holiday.

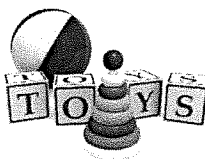

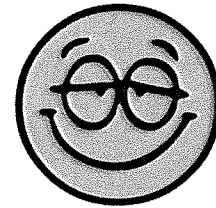
