Come for an afternoon of richness and pleasure. Refreshments will be served. "Poetry is when an emotion has found its thought and the thought has found words."

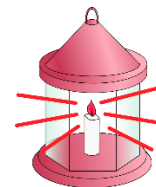

Spring “Green” Cleaning Tips
