### **HOW CAN YOU HELP?**

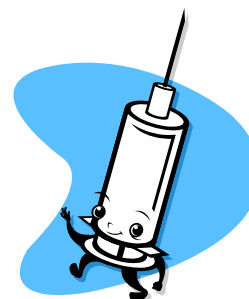
1. Donate something for our new and nearly new “treasure” room.
